

Obtaining or purchasing FHP is often a significant challenge and the reality for many girls and women living in poverty. For homeless females, this challenge magnifies. Health risks are also associated with lack of access to these products.

We want to ensure that you and your colleagues are recognized for participating in this local campaign. The collection drive could run for 2 weeks or a drive could occur at a monthly team meeting. The length and time frame is totally up to your workplace. Once this initiative is complete, I will provide a report back summary to those who participated.
